

ITAL-3043. Italian Cinema

This course explores the history and evolution of Italian cinema from the silent era to the present day. Students will analyze the works of major directors such as Fellini, Pasolini, and Antonioni, and discuss the social and cultural context of Italian film. The course includes screenings of key films and a final research paper.

Latin**LATI-1013. Introduction to Latin I**

This course provides a foundation in Latin grammar and vocabulary. Students will learn to read and understand Latin texts, focusing on the works of Cicero and Virgil. The course includes a final exam and a research paper.

LATI-1023. Introduction to Latin II

This course continues the study of Latin grammar and vocabulary, focusing on the works of Tacitus and Pliny. Prerequisite: LATI 1013. The course includes a final exam and a research paper.

LATI-2103. Latin III (Intermediate)

This course focuses on advanced Latin grammar and vocabulary, with a focus on the works of Seneca and Ovid. Prerequisite: LATI 1023. The course includes a final exam and a research paper.

LATI-3103. Latin IV (Intermediate)

This course focuses on advanced Latin grammar and vocabulary, with a focus on the works of Augustine and Jerome. Prerequisite: LATI 2103. The course includes a final exam and a research paper.

Romance Languages**ROML-2013. Introduction to Linguistics I**

This course introduces students to the field of linguistics, covering the history and theory of the discipline. Students will explore the structure of language and the relationship between language and society. The course includes a final exam and a research paper.

ROML-2023. Introduction to Linguistics II

This course continues the study of linguistics, focusing on the structure of language and the relationship between language and society. Students will explore the structure of language and the relationship between language and society. The course includes a final exam and a research paper.
